Technology for Teaching Translation

Case Studies in Chinese/English



This presentation will report on a recent project undertaken by Dr. Shengyu Fan and Grazia Scotellaro to introduce the use of apps and online resources in teaching Translation and Interpreting in Chinese for CAP.

The project initially set out to test and evaluate a range of technologies including Google Translate, Padlet, Scribe and Socrative among others and only the most appropriate were then used in CHIN3041/6041 course: Case Studies in Translation: Chinese/English.

One of the main aims of this project is to break out from the traditional way of teaching and assessing student learning in this field. We live in a technology rich society. Mobile technology is part of our daily lives, but in stark contrast, we still teach in a way that does not fully engage with this life and work scenario. Our aim is to teach students to be critical users of technologies, especially in the field of translation and interpreting. Translation Studies students who are exposed to a variety of practical uses of modern technology are better equipped to work in the 21st century.
