You can read or recite a poem in a language other than English - or more than one language - at one of our showcases:

- Friday 16 February, at 5.00pm; and
- Saturday 17 February at 8.50pm.

You will have 4 minutes to read or recite your own original poem, or a favourite in your language, and give a short explanation or a translation in English. Some poets write in a mixture of languages, including some English.
