APPLICATION FOR THE FIPLV SCHOLARSHIP

What is the *FIPLV Congress 1988 Scholarship*?

This scholarship was established after the success of the 1988 FIPLV World Congress on language learning which was hosted by the MLTA ACT Inc. It provides financial assistance for teachers wishing to further their professional development by means of travel and associated experience of educational programs **or** to develop a special language program.

Who can apply?

Each financial MLTA ACT Inc. member who:

- is an **active member** of the MLTA ACT Inc. and who has been a financial member for at least two years prior to applying for the scholarship.
- intends to continue to work as a languages teacher.
- will use the scholarship within twelve months of receipt.
- will submit a report of their activity for publication in CONTACT newsletter for the benefit of members of the MLTA ACT Inc. and/or present at one of the events organised by the MLTA ACT Inc, as requested by the MLTA ACT Inc Executive Committee.

How to apply?

Your application must include the details below and any other information that would be of assistance:

- Full name
- Current school
- Number of years as an individual member of the MLTA ACT Inc.
- Language teaching experience
- Outline of any contribution made to teaching languages beyond the applicants own school
- Details of the proposed activity including dates, costs and other assistance, which the applicant may receive for the proposal
- Describe how this proposal will benefit yourself, your school and the language teaching community in the ACT
- Outline of previous overseas experience of any kind (if applying to go overseas).
- List any previous FIPLV Scholarships received

Who is on the selection committee?

For the FIPLV Congress 1988 Scholarships for 2021, a panel formed from members of the Executive Committee of the MLTA ACT Inc. will review all applications. Successful applicants will be notified of the Executive Committee's decision no later than 3:00pm Friday 13 August 2021. The names of the successful applicants will be forwarded to the Treasurer of the MLTA ACT Inc.

Funds will be reimbursed to the applicants when receipts are provided, not in advance.

The decision of the Executive Committee shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into in respect to any decision made. The Executive Committee will not publish their reasons for any decision reached or any aspect of the FIPLV Congress 1988 Scholarships for 2021.
