Workshop focus:

Of all the language skills, listening is the most important for the development of second language acquisition and proficiency. In this workshop, Dr Gianfranco Conti will aim to provide classroom practitioners with a 360-degree understanding of the listening process and to equip them with a wide range of instructional strategies which will support the acquisition of bottom-up and top-down processing strategies. Based on cognitive models of skill-acquisition, the approach advocated involves developing capacity in beginner-to-intermediate listeners during the formative years through the intensive and extensive modelling of language and micro-skills. The workshop will delve into ear-training, vocabulary instruction, parsing-skills development, meaning and discourse building strategies as well as interactional listening.
