

## Expression of Interest - ANU Extension Program 2020 Year 11 and 12 Program

### Teaching in year 11 or/and 12 Continuing Japanese program.

#### Background information

ANU Extension is the University's extension program for senior secondary students. The program offers courses in sciences, engineering, mathematics and Asian languages. Student's course scores will be credited toward the ACT Senior Secondary Certificate and may be eligible to be used in the calculation of the Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) in the ACT. #### Teaching Position

##### Job Description:

Teachers delivering the ANU Extension program in 2020 will teach one class of Continuing Japanese. The program is run on the ANU campus in the afternoon or early evening on Wednesdays or Thursdays. This positions will attract a remuneration package classification as casual sessional academics at level B1 on the basis of 2 contact hours per week. Teachers work collaboratively with other teaching staff in their program and staff from the ANU in the delivery of programs, generally with 2hrs/wk of contact time. ANU Extension courses are registered by the ACT Board of Senior Secondary Studies (BSSS) and are also accredited ANU courses.

Applicants will need to demonstrate their capability, qualifications and experience against the following:

- Evidence of high quality teaching experiences in the secondary and/or tertiary sector in the discipline area sought
- Evidence of capacity to achieve consistently high student outcomes through contemporary pedagogy and classroom practice
- Capacity and commitment to work as part of a team and in collaborative practice, including overriding program meetings and events
- Demonstrate or be willing to undertake professional development in the development of resources that may be used online to support the current programs
- Demonstrate or be willing to undertake professional development in the assessment processes of the Board of Senior Secondary Studies (BSSS)
- Teachers will be required to have a current ACT Working with Vulnerable People registration before commencing in the program.
