Defence requires the delivery of an **Intermediate to Higher level Indonesian course** and an **Advanced Refresher language training course** in Canberra during 2019. The course will be a general language course to develop Indonesian language skills to the Higher and Advanced levels.

The course will be for up to six Defence members who have had prior Indonesian language training, having achieved Intermediate level proficiency based on the Australian Defence Language Proficiency Rating Scale (ADLPRS).

For Higher Level: The goal of the course will be to develop reading, translating, speaking and listening skills to improve the members' language abilities and confidence in using Indonesian. Civilian members will be required to focus on developing skills to level 3 for Listening and Reading, and level 2+ for Translation skills (Indonesian to English) while Australian Defence Force (ADF) members will be required to focus on developing skills to level 3 for Reading, Listening and Speaking. Providers are encouraged to include interpreting and writing activities for language learning purposes, but tests in these skills are not required as an outcome for the course.

For Advanced Refresher Level: The goal of the course will be to refresh reading, translating, speaking and listening skills to improve the members' language abilities and confidence in using Indonesian. Civilian members will be required to focus on developing skills to level 3+ for Listening and Reading, and level 3 for Translation skills (Indonesian to English) while Australian Defence Force (ADF) members will be required to focus on developing skills to level 3+ for Reading, Listening and Speaking. Providers are encouraged to include interpreting and writing activities for language learning purposes, but tests in these skills are not required as an outcome for the course.
